Upper Level Supportive Elective: BIO 4301 Immunology (Pre-req: BIO 2306 and 1 from BIO 3342, 4306, or 4308; grades of C or better). Students who plan to apply to Physician Assistant School bear ultimate responsibility for determining specific coursework required of the school. Note that students planning to apply to the UT Health Science Center in San Antonio must complete a biochemistry class as a prerequisite for that program. These students must qualify and register for CHE 4341 as their HHPR Restricted Elective.

Professional Field Experience: HP 4V79 Internship in Human Performance. Must have 60 hrs earned and attend mandatory internship meeting one year prior to field experience. Internships for academic credit must be approved by program director and comply with University policy. First Aid and CPR certifications are strongly recommended for field experience. The internship may be 3-6 credit hours. GPA Requirement: No requirements for incoming FR to declare. To declare the HSS major as a transfer, students must be eligible to register for both BIO 1305 and 1105 and CHE 1301 and 1101 or have completed these courses. Students who wish to change their major to Health Science Studies after completing coursework at Baylor must be eligible to register for the courses above as well as has a cumulative GPA of 3.2. Students with completed coursework can only change into the major at the end of a full semester when grades post throug hthe 5th class day of the following term. Students whose cumulative GPA falls below the minimum requirement in any semester will be placed on probation for one semester. Students whose cumulative GPA falls below the required minimum for their track for a second consecutive semester must select another major or alternative track for which they do have the Students not meeting criteria for admission to the major are encouraged to enroll in the Pre-HSS program which will allow them to be advised, counseled, and tracked by the RCHHS Advising Office. From within this program, students who demonstrate ability to meet GPA and course readiness requirements may transition into the Health Science Studies major. Students may not stay in the Pre-HSS program once they have 30 hrs at Baylor. If a student has completed 30 hrs and still does not meet the criteria for admission to the HSS major, they will have to choose another
